

Notice on Fee Changes for Foreign Patients Without Japanese Public Health Insurance

Effective Sunday, February 1, 2026, our hospital will revise the fees for patients who do not hold Japanese nationality and are not enrolled in any valid Japanese public health insurance system. The medical service fee point value will be changed from 10 yen per point to 20 yen per point.

Under Japan's public health insurance system, each medical service—including examinations, treatments, and hospital stays—is assigned a specific number of medical fee points. These points are calculated at 10 yen per point, and patients pay a portion of the cost depending on their type of health insurance coverage. Since this medical system is funded by insurance premiums and taxes paid by Japanese citizens, we consider it reasonable to request foreign visitors to bear an additional cost equivalent to this support. As a result of this revision, the payment amount for applicable patients will be twice the standard self-pay medical fees.
